

POLICE DEPARTMENT FAQ'S

How do I obtain an accident or incident report?	Reports are normally ready between 2-10 days and the fee is 3.50. Accident reports can be picked up at the Police Department Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. thru 5:00 p.m. Incident reports require an Open Records Request which can be obtained through the Police Department Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. thru 5:00 p.m.
How do I find out if someone is in jail?	Call the Johnson County Sheriff's Office at 817-556-6005.
Does the Police Department do fingerprinting?	Yes. Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. thru 5:00 p.m. The cost is 5.00 per card.
How do I make a police report for an offense?	If it is an emergency – call 911. For non-emergency situations call the Johnson County Sheriff's Office at 817-556-6060 to have a Joshua Police Department Officer dispatched.
