**Council to Consider Annexation and Speed Limits During June 18<sup>th</sup> Meeting**

During this month's City Council Meeting, the Council will consider an Ordinance annexing approximately 49.92 acres are land within the eastern portion of the current extra-territorial jurisdiction (ETJ) of the City. The Council will also consider an Ordinance to change the speed limit on Main Street between 10<sup>th</sup> Street and 16<sup>th</sup> Street from 20 miles per hour (mph) to 30 mph. In addition, the Council will receive a progress report on design and land acquisition for the City park. The Council meeting begins at 7:00 pm Thursday June 18<sup>th</sup> at City Hall.
