Joshua Voters Pass All Three Bond Propositions

On November 3, 2009, Joshua voters passed all three propositions on the ballot totaling more than 6 million dollars in projects recommended to the City Council by the Citizens Capital Improvement Study Committee.

Proposition I \$2,700,000 to fund design and construction of a new central fire station.
