## **REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS**

On or about November 8, 2010 the City of Joshua will submit a request to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the release of Economic Development Initiative funds under H.R. 111-366 of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2010, as amended, to undertake a project known as Joshua City Park for the purpose of construction and equipment for park areas, located at 831 North Main Street, Joshua Texas 76058.

## **FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT**

The City of Joshua has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at City of Joshua, City Hall, 101 S. Main St. Joshua Texas 76058 and may be examined or copied weekdays 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

## **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Any individual, group, or agency disagreeing with this determination or wishing to comment on the project may submit written comments to the City Secretary, City of Joshua, 101 S. Main St. Joshua Texas 76058. All comments received by November 5, 2010 will be considered by the City of Joshua prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which part of this Notice they are addressing.

## **RELEASE OF FUNDS**

The City of Joshua certifies to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development that Paulette Hartman in her capacity as City Manager consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows the City of Joshua to use Program funds.

## **OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS**

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development will consider objections to its release of funds and the City of Joshua's certification received by November 22, 2010 for a period of fifteen days from its receipt of the request only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer or other officer of the City of Joshua approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; (b) the City of Joshua has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the project have committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development at 451 Seventh Street SW, Room 7146, Washington DC, 20410. Potential objectors should contact HUD to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
