## CITY OF JOSHUA, TEXAS

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 811-2021**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOSHUA, TEXAS, AMENDING THE THOROUGHFARE MASTER PLAN CONTAINED IN THE 2016 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN BY REMOVING THE EXISTING 2-LANE COLLECTOR ROADWAY FROM SH 174 TO CR 1023 AND DESIGNATING CR 904 WEST OF SH 174 AS A 2-LANE COLLECTOR ROADWAY; MAKING FINDINGS RELATIVE THERETO; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Joshua, Texas ("City"), in its 2016 Comprehensive Plan adopted a Thoroughfare Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that a portion of its Thoroughfare Master Plan should be amended by removing the existing 2-Lane Collector Roadway from SH 174 to CR 1023 and designating CR 904 west of SH 174 as a 2-Lane Collector Roadway; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the proposed amendment to the Thoroughfare Master Plan is in the best interests of the citizens of the City and will promote the public health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further has determined that the proposed amendment to the Thoroughfare Master Plan will promote the orderly, safe and efficient growth of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOSHUA, TEXAS, THAT:

## SECTION 1

All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if copied in their entirety.

## **SECTION 2**

From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the Thoroughfare Master Plan, contained in the 2016 Comprehensive Plan, is hereby amended by removing the existing 2-Lane Collector Roadway from SH 174 to CR 1023 and designating CR 904 west of SH 174 as a 2-Lane Collector Roadway.

#### **SECTION 3**

If any word, section, article, phrase, paragraph, sentence, clause, or portion of this ordinance or application thereto to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance; and the City Council hereby declares it would have passed such remaining portions of this ordinance despite such invalidity which remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

# **SECTION 4**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication, as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.
