BOND PROPOSITION B

The city proposes \$10 million in the upcoming bond election for the construction or reconstruction of various streets, roads, and intersections, including related improvements to help improve mobility and safety along streets and roadways, reduce congestion, and address aging infrastructure.

Facts

Potential projects for funding were chosen based on the five-year Capital Improvement Plan and the City Council's current strategic priorities. These plans focus on various factors intended to meet the city's infrastructure needs.

Annual Projects

Funds are set aside on a yearly basis to address project needs as they arise. These are expected to include projects like intersection turn lanes and safety improvements, traffic signals, street pavement repairs, and pedestrian accessibility improvements.

Streets Reconstruction

Many of Joshua's streets have reached the end of useful life and are in need of repair and reconstruction. Bond funds will be used to address the reconstruction of aging infrastructure.
